O P I N I O N

Glendale City Lines, a California corporation, presently renders service as a passenger stage corporation in and about the City of Glendale, California. Included is authority to carry school children between the Glen-Vet Court, on Colorado Street in the City of Los Angeles, and the Thomas Edison School at Colorado and Vano Streets in the City of Glendale. ⁽¹⁾ It is approximately 2,500 feet from the court to the school. The City of Glendale guaranteed applicant a minimum of \$10.00 per school day for this service.

By the application herein filed on July 29, 1955, authority is sought to discontinue service between the Glen-Vet Court and the Thomas Edison School.

In support of this request, applicant alleges that the Glen-Vet Court has been closed. Attached to the application and marked Exhibit "A" is a copy of a letter from the Assistant City Manager of the City of Glendale, requesting that the described service be discontinued immediately.

Having fully considered the matter, we find that the proposed abandonment is not adverse to the public interest. The requested authority will be granted.

O R D E R

The Commission having found that the proposed abandonment is not adverse to the public interest,

IT IS ORDERED that Glendale City Lines, Inc., is authorized to abandon and discontinue service between Glen-Vet Court on Colorado Street, in the City of Los Angeles, on the one hand, and the Thomas Edison School, on Colorado and Vine Streets in the City of Glendale, on the other hand, rendered via the following route:

Commencing at the Glen-Vet Court on Colorado Street in the City of Los Angeles, thence via Colorado Street and Pacific Avenue to the Thomas Edison School at Pacific Avenue and Vine Street, in the City of Glendale;

which service was authorized by Decision No. 42630, dated March 22, 1949, in Application No. 29964.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
