ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to widen Union Avenue at separated grades under the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and alter Sonora Street at grade with said tracks in the City of Bakersfield, Kern County, as shown by Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" attached to the application, identified as Crossings Nos. 2-886.5-B and 2-886.4, respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
