## OPINION

S. Highways 99, 99E, 99W, and 40, serving all intermediate points on U. S. Highways 99, 99E, and 99W, and all off-route points between U. S. Highways 99E and 99W (all connecting highways as alternate routes), and between Martinez, Pittsburg, Nichols and Permanente, on the one hand, and Red Bluff and intermediate points north of Sacramento on U. S. Highways 99, 99E and 99W, and off-route points between U. S. Highways 99E and 99W, on the other hand, via U. S. Highway 101, and connecting routes to Permanente; and U. S. Highway 40, State Highways 4 and 24, and connecting routes, to Martinez, Pittsburg, and Nichols.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.
