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SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates for the transportation of sand, rock, gravel and related items in dump truck equipment within Orange County are set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7. Zone rates are provided for movements between designated production areas and delivery zones. Mileage rates and hourly rates apply between points not covered by zone rates. The mileage and hourly rates are generally higher than the zone rates.

By petition for Modification No. 16, California Dump Truck Owners' Association, Inc., seeks the extension of the zone rate system to cover deliveries from the recently established production facility of Construction and Materials Co., Inc., in the vicinity of Olinda, located outside the present production areas.

According to the petition, the average monthly production will be several thousand tons of road base material, much of which will be transported by for-hire dump trucks. Petitioner states that the establishment of zone rates as proposed would benefit carriers, shippers and the general public. The Commission staff has conducted a study of this transportation and recommends that the zone rate system be extended as proposed.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection to its being granted has been received.

The petition will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. The rates hereinafter provided are reasonable and suitable minimum rates for the transportation in question.


