FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On June 9, 1955, the Commission by Decision No. 51567 issued a license to Frank D. Davi authorizing him to engage in business as a motor transportation broker at 143 Drumm Street, San Francisco.

By his supplemental application the Commission is requested to amend that license to authorize him to conduct his business at 1188 Harrison Street, San Francisco, instead of the above address.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) Paragraph (1)(b) of the order of Decision No. 51567 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) That licensee shall conduct business as a motor transportation broker at 1188 Harrison Street, San Francisco, California, and for motor carriers hereinafter named or for whom he may hereafter, from time to time, be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission."

(2) The license certificate heretofore issued to Frank D. Davi bearing the date of the 16th day of June, 1955, is hereby rescinded and shall be surrendered to the Commission.

(3) The Secretary of the Commission shall issue and deliver to Frank D. Davi, in lieu of the license referred to in Paragraph (2) hereof, a new license certificate as a motor transportation broker in the form heretofore approved by the Commission for such license certificate and subject to conditions specified in Decision No. 51567 as hereby amended.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
