ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 46429, dated November 20, 1951, in the above-numbered application that Al Calkins was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and their baggage and of express between San Luis Obispo and Cambria Pines serving intermediate points; and it further appearing that said Al Calkins does not have on file adequate insurance protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage as required by General Order No. 101; and that the passenger stage service in question was discontinued on August 22, 1954, by authority of this Commission for a period of one year, and that applicant now requests an additional suspension for another year but without stating any reason in justification of such relief, and the Commission being of the opinion that such relief should not be granted and said operative rights should be revoked; now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Al Calkins pursuant to said Decision No. 46429 be, and it is hereby, revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs in the name of Al Calkins be, and they are hereby, canceled.

The secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon said Al Calkins.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon said Al Calkins unless before such effective date he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a hearing thereof, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
