## <u>ORDER</u>

The verified application of Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company, filed on August 17, 1955, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Cadwell, Sonoma County, during the past several years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Cadwell, County of Sonoma; to remove a spur track approximately 350 feet in length at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commistion in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
