<u>opinion</u>

This application was filed on November 12, 1954. By it Circle Freight Lines seeks authority to extend its service to Martinez. Public hearings were held on August 5 and September 6, 1955, in connection with another application, before Examiner John Power at San Francisco and the matter was submitted on the latter date.

Applicant shares a common ownership and control with the California Motor Express Co., Ltd. and other companies in that group. The financial resources, equipment, facilities, experience and personnel available to applicant are adequate.

Martinez is located on the southern shore of Carquinez Strait near Suisun Bay. Applicant has authority to serve several nearby points, and there seems to be no logical reason for excluding Martinez from applicant's service area. Furthermore, applicant receives numerous calls each week offering traffic to

- (3) That the certificate herein granted shall be in extension of and consolidated with the existing operating authority of applicant.
- (4) That in providing service pursuant to the authority herein granted, applicant shall comply with the following service regulations:
 - (a) Within thirty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
 - (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80 by filing in triplicate and concurrently making effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
