ORDER

By Decision No. 39752, dated December 16, 1946, in Application No. 27978, Edward S. Heyen, doing business as Oroville Transit Lines, was authorized to provide a passenger stage service between Paxton Subdivision, Pleasant Valley, Foothill District, Thermalito District, Palermo District and intermediate points.

The Commission has been informed that due to a lack of patronage service was discontinued on June 10, 1955, and the operation abandoned.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights granted by Decision No. 39752 dated December 16, 1946, in Application No. 27978 are hereby revoked and the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in

the name of Edward S. Heyen, doing business as Oroville Transit Lines, are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
