APPENDIX A

Charles Meek, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision, is authorized to transport:

- (1) Paper, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 35442 through 35771 of Western Classification No. 75, Cal. P.U.C. No. 8, of George H. Dumas, Agent, on the date of issue thereof and Supplements Nos. 27, 41 and 45 thereto, between Burlingame and San Jose and points intermediate on U.S. Highway 101 between Burlingame and San Jose.
- (2) Canned goods, as listed under that heading in Item No. 610 on Eleventh Revised Page 47 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, between San Jose, on the one hand, and Richmond, San Francisco, Oakland and Alameda, on the other hand.
- (3) Sugar between San Francisco, Spreckels, Salinas and Manteca, on the one hand, and San Jose, on the other hand.

The authority granted in paragraphs Nos. 2 and 3 hereof does not include the right to render service from, to or between intermediate points.
