OPINION

Collier Transportation Company is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and a certificate of public convenience and necessity by this Commission.

It seeks an order authorizing it to extend its operations as a highway common carrier in the transportation of lumber and forest products so as to render a state-wide service.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicant was conducting his operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
