OPINION

Glen Nolan is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.

He seeks an order authorizing him to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities generally between San Francisco, Oakland, Hayward, San Jose, Saratoga, Escalon, Richmond, Stockton, Modesto, Woodland, Sacramento and intermediate points including service to off-route points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order. It appears that applicant possesses the experience, equipment, personnel and financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Glen Nolan by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision is authorized to transport general commodities between (1) San Mateo and San Jose and intermediate points, (2) Hayward and San Jose and intermediate points, (3) San Francisco, Oakland and Berkeley, on the one hand, and Decoto, Niles and Newark, on the other hand. The authority set forth in number (3) hereof does not include the right to render service from, to or between intermediate points. Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- Uncrated, unpacked and unwrapped personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling;
- 2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps) ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses, bus chassis:
- 3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine;
- 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment;
- 5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles;
- 6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper type trucks;
- 7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
