O P I N I O N

Kenneth Paris and Dorothy Paris are engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to a permit issued by this Commission.

They seek an order authorizing them to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of lumber from Eureka to San Diego; cement, salt and petroleum in barrels from Redwood City and San Francisco Bay Area to Alturas; fresh fruit from Sonoma and Lake Counties to San Francisco Bay Area; general commodities from San Francisco Bay Area and Fresno Area to Alturas, Cedarville, Tule Lake and Susanville and from Los Angeles Basin to San Francisco Bay Area, Stockton and Sacramento and intermediate points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicants were conducting their operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission:

Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied.

O R D E R

The Commission has considered the application and representations filed herein, Now Therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 36314 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
