ORDER

Los Angeles Junction Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Boyle Avenue in the City of Vernon, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portion of existing Crossing No. 25-0.58. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now paved, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are

not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the side track is urgently needed at this time to facilitate the movement of its trains, and has urged that the order be made effective at once. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
