O P I N I O N

Charles J. Groskopf and Stewart R. Weider are engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued by this Commission.

They seek an order authorizing them to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of veneer from Leggett Valley and Cloverdale to Sonoma and for the transportation of plywood practically statewide.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicants were conducting their operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied.

The Commission has considered the application and representations filed herein, Now Therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 35879 is denied.
