ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION  
AND DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

On September 27, 1955, this Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation respecting a revised Schedule No. 53-T which The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company sought to file under its Advice Letter No. 6184. Such order was generated by a petition of The Western Union Telegraph Company seeking suspension of the proposed tariff pending hearing and decision upon its propriety. On October 8, 1955, The Western Union Telegraph Company informed the Commission that it desired to withdraw its protest. Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the revised Schedule No. 53-T accompanying Advice Letter No. 6184 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company may become effective on the twentieth day following the date of this order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-entitled investigation be and it is hereby discontinued.
