O P I N I O N

Pacific Greyhound Lines requests authority to operate over a newly constructed highway between Castro Valley Junction and Hayward Junction as an alternate route.

An alternate route as defined in Decision No. 47907 is used for operating convenience only and excludes local service.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the proposed alternate route would expedite through schedules between Oakland and points in the San Joaquin Valley.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed, the Commission having been informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public

Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Route No. 12.30 appearing on Original Page 35-A of Appendix A, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 47907 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

(2) That Appendix A of Decision No: 47907 is hereby amended by incorporating Original Page 35-A.

(3) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs and timetables.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
