O R D E R

The City of Ripon is authorized to construct Genevieve Way at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Ripon, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-104.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the rainy season is approaching and it is vitally important that the paving be done before the weather becomes disadvantageous and the road bed impassable from the effects

of moisture. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
