O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on September 1, 1955, discloses that the number of cars of livestock handled through the applicant's stock corrals in the City of Gridley, Butte County, during the past four years no longer warrants the continued maintenance of these corrals.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its stock corrals in the City of Gridley, County of Butte, and to remove said stock corrals at said city, upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
