## ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on August 20, 1955, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Hinton during the past several years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Hinton, County of Nevada; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
