O R D E R

County of Fresno is authorized to construct Gettysburg Avenue at grade across a track of the Clovis Branch line of Southern Pacific Company near Melvin, Fresno County, at the location described in its Application No. 37274 to be identified as Crossing No. BS-215.7. Applicant, County of Fresno, shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Application No. 35903, which requests authority for the construction of a private crossing at this same location (Gettysburg Avenue), is hereby dismissed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant, County of Fresno, shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The County of Fresno desires to complete construction prior to the rainy season and has requested immediate authorization. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
