O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an industry lead track at grade across Cypress Avenue, in the City of Fullerton, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-167.3-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served is scheduling the receipt of plant material by rail to start November 16 and requests that the 20-day waiting period be waived. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
