O P I N I O N

Applicant, Key System Transit Lines, presently rendering a service for the transportation of passengers between and in the various communities of the East Bay Area, as well as between said area and the City and County of San Francisco, requests authority to operate over certain streets in order to provide service for school children in Oakland, San Leandro and Berkeley.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that with the construction of new school buildings and with the assignment of students between the old and new schools, certain difficulties have arisen in connection with the transportation of children between their homes and their respective schools and that the proposed extensions will facilitate the transportation of school children over more direct and less hazardous routes.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission having been informed in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers over and along the following streets:

1st Avenue and West Avenue 132nd between Merced Street and Doolittle Drive.

Williams Street between Doolittle Drive and Washington Avenue.

Wayne Avenue between Williams Street and Davis Street.

Grizzly Peak Boulevard between Spruce Street and Euclid Avenue.

Commencing at Mountain Boulevard and Calaveras Avenue, thence along Mountain Boulevard, Mountain View, Mountain Boulevard Cut-off, Mountain Boulevard to Calaveras Avenue.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following regulations:

(a) Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within thirty days after the date hereof.

(b) Within ninety days after the date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish said service.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
