O P I N I O N

Colberg Transportation Co., requests authority to abandon certain vessel operative rights in the Delta area generally southwest and northwest of Stockton.

At one time applicant was authorized to operate a passenger stage service in conjunction with its vessel service. The passenger stage operative rights have since been sold and transferred.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that it lost a United States mail contract in 1950; that there have been no requests for its on-call vessel service; that the public has faster means of transportation available between the points it is authorized to serve and that there was no income during the year 1954.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission having been informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the authority granted by Decision No. 41390 dated

March 30, 1948, in Application No. 29154 authorizing the transportation of passengers and property by vessels is hereby revoked and Colberg Transportation Co., a corporation, is hereby authorized to abandon all vessel service.

(2) That the tariffs and timetables on file with this Commission in the name of Colberg Transportation Co. and relating to vessel service are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
