## OPINIOQ

As justification for the authority sought applicant aileges thet it lost a United States mail contract in 1950; that there have been no requests for its on-cell vissol survico; that the pubilc hes fastur moans of transportetion availablo between the points it is authorized to surve and thet there wes no income during the yoar 1954.
aftor considuration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds thet the application should be granted.

## QRDER

Application heving been filed and the Commission heving beon informed in the premisos,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That the authority granted by Decision No. 41390 dated

March 30, 1948, in Application No. 29154 authorizing the trensportatron of pessungers and property by vessels is horuby revoked and Colburg Transportation Co., a corporation, is huruby authorized to abandon all russel service.
(2) That the tariffs and timetables on file with this Commission In the name of Colberg Transportation Co. and relating to vessel service are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
