O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Castro Street in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AAC-18.24-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs, (G.O. No. 75B), reflectorized by reflex-reflecting sheet material. Supplemental protection at the crossing shall be provided by the installation of adequate safety lighting to operate during the hours of darkness. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
