SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It appears that the Commission, on mimeographed page 1 of Decision No. 51899, dated August 30, 1955, inadvertently stated:

"The application does not contain evidence sufficient to constitute a showing that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of the proposed service. The application will therefore be denied."

instead of:

"Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicant was conducting his operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied."

Now Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 51899, dated August 30, 1955, in Application No. 36380, is amended by deleting therefrom the last paragraph on mimeographed page 1 thereof and inserting in place and stead the following:

"Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicant was conducting his operations within

the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied."
