O P I N I O N

El Jo Corporation requests authority to suspend service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for a period of one year.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that it wishes to cease operations for the purpose of revising its financial structure.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission having been informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the operating authority granted by Decision No. 50722, dated November 11, 1954, is hereby suspended for a period of one year after the effective date hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty days after the effective date of this order applicant shall, on not less than

five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, amend its tariff to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
