OPINION

George R. Mallory is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to a permit issued by this Commission.

He seeks an order authorizing him to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of cement in bulk from Colton, Riverside, Oro Grande, Victorville, Redwood City, San Juan Bautista and Calaveras and a 10-mile radius of each of said points to all points in California south of an imaginary line drawn through San Francisco and Stockton.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order. It appears that applicant possesses the experience, equipment, personnel and financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

Applicant is hereby placed upon notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may

(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

George R. Mallory, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision, is authorized to transport cement in bulk between Colton and Riverside, on the one hand, and El Centro, Calexico, Brawley, Arlington, Holtville and Calipatria, on the other hand, and between Kentucky House and Redwood City Harbor, on the one hand, and El Monte, Vernon, Redondo Beach and North Long Beach, on the other hand.

Such authority does not include the right to render service to; from or between intermediate points.
