ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed June 8, 1955 the Draymen's Association of San Francisco and the Draymen's Association of Alameda County request that the surcharge applicable to minimum rates for the transportation of property between points in the San Francisco Bay Counties area be increased to 20 per cent.

The matter has been set for hearing and postponed five times. Petitioner has requested that hearing be further postponed until February 1956.

Since the filing of the petition the surcharge involved herein has been increased from 6 to 11 per cent by Decision No. 51688, dated July 18, 1955. There have also been increases in other minimum rate tariffs covering transportation within the area.

In the light of petitioners' request for further postponement of this matter and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition filed in this proceeding on June 8, 1955, by the Draymen's Association of San Francisco

and the Draymen's Association of Alameda County, be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
