APPENDIX A

Evelyn O. Simmonds, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision, is authorized to transport general commodities between:

- (1) San Mateo and San Jose and intermediate points.
- (2) Crockett and Vallejo, serving Benicia as an off-route point.
- (3) The points set forth in paragraphs Nos. (1) and (2) hereof and the points Evelyn O. Simmonds is authorized to serve pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 51216 dated March 15, 1955, in Application No. 36668, as amended by the above-numbered decision.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- (a) Used household goods and personal effects.
- (b) Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps) ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses, bus chassis.
- (c) Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids; lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- (d) Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
- (e) Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
- (f) Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper type trucks.
- (g) Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
