Mike Conrotto by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the above-numbered decision is authorized to transport:
(1) Property to or from canneries, processing plants, and packing houses; wooden crates, including box or crate material, wood or wood and wire combined; fiberboard, paper or pulpboard boxes; burlap, gunny, cellulose, ixtie (istle), jute, sisal and paper bags; paper or vegetable parchment wrappers; fruits, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen), vegetables, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen), including fresh mushrooms; over and along the following routes:
(a) U.S. Highways 101, 101 By-Pass, 101 Aternate, between points in the San Francisco Territory and the California-Mexico border, with the right to use all roads and highways in San Francisco Territory.
(b) U.S. Highway 99 between Sacramento and the California-Mexico border.
(c) U.S. Highway 60 between Los Angeles and the California-Arizona state line.
(d) U.S. Highway 80 between San Diego and Holtvilie.
(e) With the right to serve between points within San Francisco Territory.
(f) With the right to serve points and places located laterally within 15 miles of the above routes.
(g) With the right to serve intermediate points.
(h) With the right to use any and all connecting roads and highways for operating convenience only.
(2) Wooden crates; burlap, gunny, cellulose, ixtle (1stie), jute, sisal and paper bags; paper or vegetable parchment wrappers; and fiberboard, paper or pulpboard boxes,

Between Los Angeles, Indsay, Porterville, Strathmore, Ivanhoe and Lemon Cove.

(3) Frults, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen), vegetables, fresh or green (not cold pack or frozen), including fresh mushrooms, over and along the following route:
(a) State Kifghway 33 between Maricopa and Patterson.
(b) With the right to serve points and places located laterally within 25 miles of the above route.
(c) With the right to serve intermediate points.
