O R D E R

The City of Manteca is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing of South Main Street at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. B-96.9) in the City of Manteca, San Joaquin County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense, exclusive of expense of protection, shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. The installation cost of flashing light signals shall be borne equally by the Southern Pacific Company and the City of Manteca. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
