ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The petition filed February 14, 1955 by Roc Ross and Gil Gouveia, doing business as Re-Ly-On Van Service, seeks amendment of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 11-A so that the minimum rates set forth in that tariff would apply to the transportation of uncrated new office furniture from retail stores and retail store warehouses. The matter had been set for hearing for March 25, 1955, and then on April 15, 1955. On both occasions the petition was removed from the Commission's hearing calendar at the petitioners' request.

Petitioners recently informed the Commission that they were not prepared to prosecute the petition as filed and that it appearing probable to them that before proceeding they would desire to amend the petition in several respects, they would not be adverse to a dismissal of the petition without prejudice to their filing a new one.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 1 in Case No. 5603 be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
