FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 51595, dated June 21, 1955, the United States of America was authorized to construct two crossings at grade across State Highway Route 78, in the County of Riverside, which provided, among other things, for maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails to be borne by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company.

Applicant has filed a petition for modification of that order, requesting that the maintenance cost be modified to conform with an existing agreement entered into with the railway.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the second and third sentences be deleted from said order and the following sentence be substituted therefor:

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

In all other respects, Decision No. 51595 shall remain in full force and effect.
