O P I N I O N

Paul Burnette, presently authorized to render a passenger stage service between Jamestown, Sonora, and the Beardsley and Donnell damsites by virtue of Decision No. 51664, dated July 12, 1955, in Application No. 37035, requests authority to suspend service for a period of six months.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the primary purpose of the service is to transport workers to the damsites; that full scale operations have not as yet been conducted at the projects and are not expected to commence until after the winter months; and that service will be subsequently restored to meet the transportation needs of the workers.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the authority sought should be granted.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Paul Burnette is hereby authorized to suspend passenger stage service between Jamestown, Sonora, and the Beardsley and Donnell damsites as authorized by Decision No. 51664, dated

July 12, 1955, in Application No. 37035, until a need for service again arises, but service shall not be suspended for a period longer than six months after the effective date of this order.

(2) That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall amend the tariffs and timetables which he presently has on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
