ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

ROBERT W. BAXTER, 6539 San Fernando Road, Glendale, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainant was a telephone subscriber of defendant at said address, under number CHapman 5-6121; that on or about November 7, 1955 complainant's telephone facilities were disconnected by the Glendale Police Department, and complainant was arrested on suspicion of bookmaking; that said telephone facilities were not being used for any illegal purposes, nor was a complaint charging bookmaking ever filed against complainant; that complainant did not use and does not now intend to use said telephone facilities as an instrumentality to violate the law, nor in aiding or abetting such violation; and that complainant has suffered and will suffer irreparable injury and great hardship; therefore,






IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending hearing on said complaint or further Commission order thereon, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for

hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaint within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
