ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Millbrae Avenue, in the City of Millbrae, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-13.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of minimum widths to conform to the portions of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach level. Protection shall be by existing No. 8. Flashing Light Signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with automatic gate arms.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant alleges that the various industries to be served by this track find their operations being impaired pending construction of this track and for this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
