## THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Prior decisions in this proceeding have authorized William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., to suspend the operation of 27,500 square feet of warehouse space in Sacramento. The authority expired January 13, 1956. A six-month extension of the authority is sought.

Applicants assert that plans have been drawn up for the construction of a warehouse with suitable replacement space but that it cannot be completed prior to the expiration date of the present suspension authority.

In the circuistances it appears that the sought extension of the authority is justified. The supplemental application will be granted. The order will be made effective on the date hereof. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted
William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as
Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., by Decision No. 48746 of

June 23, 1953, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby reinstated and extended to July 13, 1956, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.
