CBB Decision No. BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA In the matter of the application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to abandon its non-agency station at Gish, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, to remove its facilities therefrom, Application No. 37544 to eliminate all references of Gish from its timetables and other records, and to cancel all tariffs to and from said station. <u>ORDER</u> The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company filed on December 2, 1955, discloses that no passenger or freight business has ever been transacted at applicant's station of Gish, San Bernardino County, and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. Good cause appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Gish, County of San Bernardino; to remove all facilities at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if - 1 -

not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
