ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 52421 dated December 28, 1955, in Application No. 37370 applicants were authorized to sell and transfer their operative rights and equipment to California Motor Transport Co., Ltd. Application No. 36054 will be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 36054 is hereby dismissed.
