O P I N I O N

Inland Truckers, Inc., doing business as Universal Transport System, a corporation, is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of (1) cement, cement flue dust, lime and limestone between Davenport, San Juan Bautista, Redwood City Harbor, Permanente and Kentucky House and points north of Fresno and Santa Cruz; and (2) rock and sand between Niles-Centerville and San Francisco Peninsula, and East Bay points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicant was conducting its operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. The application will therefore be denied.

O R D E R

The Commission has considered the application and representations filed herein, Now Therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 36129 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
