ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one side track at grade across county highway near the station of Owl, Riverside County at the location described in the application to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-572.6. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a minimum width of 24 feet with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that with its track force in this vicinity it is anxious to proceed with the construction at this point and requests a waiver of the usual twenty day waiting clause. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
