ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Highway Route 69 at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company, near Alvarado, Alameda County, as shown by Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application and the amendment thereto, to be identified as Crossing No. L-26.2-AC. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time

be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
