Application No. 35193 having been filed February 26, 1954, by Sacramento City Lines, Decision No. 50152 dated June 18, 1954, having been entered granting partial relief, and on September 23, 1955, final judgment in eminent domain having been entered in the Superior Court in and for the County of Sacramento and duly filed in the office of the County Clerk of said County by which judgment the operative properties of said Sacramento City Lines were acquired by the City of Sacramento, and the Order of Decision No. 51967 dated September 16, 1955, issued by this Commission having relieved said Sacramento City Lines of all obligation as a public utility, and it appearing that Sacramento City Lines has no need for a new certificate of public convenience and necessity redefining its operative rights as requested,

Now, therefore, IT IS ORDERED that further proceedings in Application No. 35193 are terminated and the matter be removed from the Commission docket.
