ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct side tracks and/or rearrange tracks at grade across the following thoroughfares: Patterson Road, Claribel Road, Second Street, Lester Road, and Gratton Road, all in the County of Stanislaus, at the locations and in the manner described in the application to be identified as a portion of Crossings Nos. 2-1096.1, 2-1094.5, 2-1089.5, 2-1080.0, and 2-1079.2 respectively.

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the roads now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway, and with grades of approach as indicated in the application. Protection at Patterson Road (Crossing No. 2-1096.1), Claribel Road (Crossing No. 2-1094.5), and Second Street (Crossing No. 2-1089.5) shall be provided by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) at each location. Protection at Lester Road (Crossing No. 2-1080.0) and Gratton Road (Crossing No. 2-1079.2) shall be by two Standard

No. 1-A crossing signs or two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflex reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
