REFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for a drill track across Rollins Road, in the City of Burlingame, County of San Mateo, State of California.

ORDER

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Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional drill track at grade across Rollins Road, in the City of Burlingame, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-13.98-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with level grades of approach. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), equipped with reflex-reflecting sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of the applicant acting as a flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

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authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
