O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Route 200 (Grove Street Underpass) at separated grades beneath, and the Costa Bella Frontage Road at grade across, the La Mesa Branch of San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, in the County of San Diego, in the manner described in the application and at the locations shown upon the maps, Exhibits "B" and "C", attached thereto, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 36D-10.7-B and 36D-10.8, respectively. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Width of Crossing No. 36D-10.8 shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
