Application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct extensions of side tracks across Jefferson Street, a County road near Le Grand, Bellevue Road, Buhach Road, and a County road in the vicinity of Fluhr, all in the County of Merced, State of California; across four County roads in the County of Madera, State of California; and across Carpenter Road and Murphy Road, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct side tracks at grade across the streets and roads shown in the following tabulation. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets and roads now graded, but not less than twenty-four feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach as indicated in the application and the amendment thereto, except that the grades of approach at Murphy Road (Crossing No. 2-1109.6) shall not exceed six percent. Protection at the crossings shall be as indicated in the tabulation.
