O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Anza Avenue as a temporary crossing at grade across the El Segundo Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company near the City of Hawthorne, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RA-15.50. This authorization is subject to the condition that upon the construction of the San Diego Freeway over the El Segundo Line and its being opened to public travel, Crossing No. 6RA-15.50 shall be abandoned and closed. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails and the cost of its subsequent abandonment, as provided for herein. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails. Width of crossing shall be not less than 52 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion of this crossing and of its subsequent abandonment, applicant shall so advise the

Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
